EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 19-07

EMERGENCY RELIEF DUE TO WEATHER EVENTS – EXECUTIVE ORDERS EXTENDED

WHEREAS, the catastrophic weather event culminating in a State of Emergency declared March 12, 2019, has resulted in widespread destruction of property; and

WHEREAS, these conditions threaten essential public health and safety services and endanger public property if response and recovery operations are disrupted.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Pete Ricketts, Governor of the State of Nebraska, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Nebraska, find these conditions constitute an on-going State of Emergency within Nebraska, as of April 10, 2019 through May 15, 2019.

Pursuant to this declaration, I hereby order the following:

1. The extension of Executive Orders 19-02, 19-03, 19-04, 19-05, and 19-06 through May 15th, 2019.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska to be affixed on this 10th day of April 2019.
