**Emergency Declaration: Hurricane/Superstorm Sandy** 

Pursuant to 35 ILCS 505/13a.4 and 35 ILCS 505/13a.5, which provides:

For commercial motor vehicles traveling into the State of Illinois, through Illinois, or returning to Illinois from a point outside Illinois, for the purpose of providing emergency goods and services to and within areas requiring disaster relief, the Director may suspend requirements for licensing or permits required by the Illinois Motor Fuel Tax Act.

Within 30 days immediately following the date of this waiver, a commercial motor vehicle traveling within the State of Illinois that is stopped or otherwise detained by order of a State or Local Law Enforcement Officer, or other lawful authority, and which is found to be operating without registration under the Illinois Motor Fuel Use Tax Act, or without a single trip permit, shall not be ticketed or otherwise penalized for such violation if the operator of the vehicle can provide proof that the destination of the vehicle is to a point within the major disaster area declared by the President of the United States under the Federal Disaster Relief Act, or that the vehicle's destination is to a point outside the State of Illinois and that the vehicle's last destination was within the major disaster area.
