BALLOT UPDATE:

IFTA Short Track Ballot 2-2008 has passed with an effective date upon passage (December 10, 2008).

IFTA Full Track Ballot voting period ends on January 20, 2009.

Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC)

The Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC) is hard at work on two projects, a Revoked Carrier's database/NLETS and a Best Practices guide.

The Revoked carriers database/NLETS is a two part project. Part one is for Law Enforcement personnel with access to the clearinghouse to be able to access a revoked motor carrier database directly in the clearinghouse. The second part is when a roadside enforcement officer utilizes NLETS to makes an inquiry through NLETS and grab the revoked status data.

The Committee is also working to define a Best Practices guide regarding uniformity within IFTA specifically in the areas of Taxpayer forms (IFTA-100, IFTA-101s, renewal application forms etc.) which are filed with a base jurisdiction and Electronic filing applications of a base jurisdiction.

The ITAC is continuing to grow and is still looking for members. If you or someone in your jurisdiction is interested in being considered for this committee please submit their names to me. We look forward to welcoming you to our committee!

It's Annual Report time again. This year the Agreement Procedures Committee has made a few small changes to the database to clarify and assist you with the data that that is to be reported.

- Number of IFTA accounts we added the Procedures Manual Reference P1110.300.005

- Number of Licenses Cancelled added Articles of Agreement reference R215
- Number of Licenses Suspended added Articles of Agreement reference R260
- Number of Licenses Revoked added Articles of Agreement reference R257
- Added hover box: to Number of Audits with Assessment:
 (Includes audits with assessments or refunds. Does not include "no change" audits)
- · Number of decals Issued changed to Number of sets of decals issued

The Annual Report Database will be open for your input beginning January 1, 2009. If you are looking for a list of all of the information you will need to complete your annual report please refer to the Procedures Manual, Section P1110.100. The due date for submitting the Annual Reports are *March 1, 2009*.

And don't forget to update the Exemption Database. By editing your information that is currently contained in the Exemption Database you will be letting the other jurisdictions know that your exemptions are current.

You'll see Annual Report, General Report, and Audit Report.

The Annual Report needs to be updated before March 1, 2009. The General and Audit report can be updated anytime throughout the year.

To update your jurisdictions exemptions. Just click on the Edit/Update button in the Master Control. The other choices are to add or delete exemptions.

New Link


There is a new link on the top of the transmittal home page called Recent Updates. This link will show you the latest updated for the past 30 days. So if you ever question why you nave not received a Transmittal E-Mail Notification, this is the page to check out. If there are any issues on our side with the auto e-mails, again, check this page out for all the latest transmittal posting.

Funds Netting

Funds netting monetary testing has ended. We will continue to provide funds netting totals between our test jurisdictions. A page was added to allow for your jurisdiction to see all transmittals and totals that the other jurisdictions are reporting to you. Before we only had what you were reporting to everyone else, so this adds an easier way to view the transmittal details and summary totals. Look for the button that says Travel Jurisdiction Report. Pick you jurisdiction first, then click the button.

Transmittal Reports

'Report 7a' is a new report we added this month. It will allow you to choose a Travel Jurisdiction and you will get the total miles reported from, to and within your jurisdiction. In this case your jurisdiction is the travel jurisdiction.
