JURISDICTION COMMUNICATION LISTS

IFTA, Inc. has come to the decision that Jurisdiction Communication Lists (JCL) will no longer be provided with the monthly mailings. This decision was made based upon the number of changes that can occur within a jurisdiction over the course of a year. Rather than provide changes that may, in some instances become obsolete once released, IFTA, Inc. has decided to suspend this practice effective immediately.

Currently, when a jurisdiction amends their JCL, IFTA, Inc. provides copies of these changes on a monthly basis. The full JCL is provided on the secure IFTA, Inc. website to its members and these records are automatically updated by the jurisdiction as needed. Non-members can access a carrier contact that is provided for on the public website and, when revised by a jurisdiction, this information is also automatically updated. Therefore both membership and non-members have access to accurate information at all times.

Should the carrier contact data shown on the website (visit One Stop Shop and select your jurisdiction of choice) be incomplete or insufficient, contact IFTA, Inc. for further jurisdictional contact information.



MANAGERS' AND LAW ENFORCEMENT WORKSHOP



Recently the Nevada DMV/Motor Carrier had a customer come and request to purchase a drive away permit which allows him to drive from Nevada to his destination in California. When asked why he needed a permit, he informed my employee that he just had a truck/tractor that he had purchased in California delivered in Verdi, Nevada, just past the California border. When asked why he would do that when he was now driving it back across the border to California, he informed DMV it was all to avoid California sales/use tax. In the end, the tech made copies of all the documents presented as proof of ownership to permit the vehicle. Those documents were then scanned and sent to a contact in the California IFTA program.

How did Nevada know to whom such communications should be sent? It was because of the 2011 IFTA Managers' and Law Enforcement Workshop where they had met. Not only was the CA representative able to direct NV to the right person for assistance, it was a quick and painless process to notify California about a case of evasion. Why would Nevada notify California about this carrier? It was thought that if he was evading California on sales/use tax there was a probability that the carrier was not reporting IFTA usage either. In conclusion this meant the carrier was not just evading California, but evading everyone within the IFTA community.

How often do you wish you knew someone in another jurisdiction when you had questions or issues? Recently IFTA, Inc. and IRP, Inc. hosted the 2012 IFTA / IRP Managers' and Law Enforcement Workshop in Mesa, AZ. With well over 80 attendants there were a diverse representation from the IFTA and IRP jurisdictions, Industry, FHWA and Mexico. Those in attendance received not only the latest in information concerning IFTA/IRP, Law Enforcement, Industry and the jurisdictions, but they met and exchanged information with numerous people who would be an asset to their IFTA / IRP Law Enforcement program.

While it might be early to start planning your attendance at next year's Workshop scheduled for October 23-25, 2013 in Mesa, Arizona, it is anticipated that next year's workshop will be bigger than ever! 
Illinois Uses 'Carriers in Multiple Jurisdictions' Link

I learned from the IFTA/IRP Managers, Law Enforcement meeting that Illinois makes use of the 'Carriers in Multiple Jurisdictions' link on the Clearinghouse Demographics page.

This link is used to find a carrier licensed in another Jurisdiction.

Illinois said they use this link to find Active Carriers active in other jurisdictions as well as in Illinois. Since an IFTA Carrier should only be registered in one jurisdiction.

The link also allows you to find any carrier operating in your jurisdiction with any status type in another jurisdiction.



View Your Data
