4Q 2015 ITEMS FROM THE BOARD

On October 20 – 21, the IFTA, Inc. Board of Trustees held its Fourth Quarter 2015 Board meeting at the IFTA, Inc. offices. Eight Board members were present and Mr. Trent Knoles (IL) attended via conference call. Ms. Sandy Johnson, NorthStar Fleet Solutions and Industry Advisory Committee (IAC) Chair, as well as Mr. Robert Pitcher, American Trucking Associations, Inc. and a member of the IAC Steering Committee, also attended. Mr. Josh Waitz, JP Morgan Chase Investment Banker, was also in attendance to provide the investment report to the Board. During this two-day meeting many relevant issues were addressed. Some of these matters included, but were not limited, to the following:

- Minutes from the 2Q15 Board meeting were approved as amended.
- Minutes of the Board actions by Email from July 1 through September 30, 2015 were approved as presented.
- A Consent Agenda containing the reports of the Audit Committee (AC), Agreement Procedures Committee (APC), Attorneys' Section Steering Committee (ASSC), Dispute Resolution Committee (DRC), and Program Compliance Review Committee (PCRC) was approved as presented.
- A website demonstration was offered reviewing the recent updates and ongoing projects related to the website modernization design.
- Alberta is in the testing phases of joining the clearinghouse.
- An IFTA App is available through Google Play to verify the status of any licensed IFTA carrier. Currently, the app only contains test data. Information displayed through the app, once a valid license is entered, includes the carrier's license number, status, base jurisdiction, and company name. It was the position of the Board that a survey be distributed to membership asking for opinions regarding the release of this type of information through an application. If a majority of the membership is not in agreement with releasing this data, the app will be retracted and actual data will not populate it.
- Demographic and transmittal data has been uploaded to the Clearinghouse which does not comply with the Clearinghouse definitions.
- The Board inquired as to how jurisdictions are notified. It was explained that an email is generated following the upload of the jurisdiction's data through the IFTA, Inc. clearinghouse. Currently the quickest recourse is for the jurisdictions to review their data prior to submission.
- IFTA, Inc. will research additional clearinghouse reports that would allow membership to write and run their own types of reports.

- IFTA, Inc. is providing a service to non-CVISN jurisdictions. Non-CVISN jurisdictions have the
 opportunity to sign an MOU allowing IFTA, Inc. to provide license status information to SAFER.
 Nevada has taken advantage of this service. Others have signed the MOU but have not yet
 authorized IFTA, Inc. to provide the data. New Hampshire recently submitted test data, but is
 waiting on confirmation from SAFER before proceeding with live data.
- Mr. Waitz informed the Board that, while 2015 has been a rough year for many investors, the
 investments made by IFTA, Inc. are diverse and conservative. As a result, the investments have
 done well. Mr. Waitz recommended that the Board keep the portfolio as it currently stands and
 that the portfolio be reviewed again in 2016.
- In early September, the SOCII and financial audits of IFTA, Inc. were completed by Lumbard and Associates. The results of these audits will not be available until January 2016.
- Ohio issued checks for funds netting back in July. However, moving forward, the jurisdiction does
 not anticipate having to repeat the distribution of checks. Concern was expressed for the
 possibility of other jurisdictions needing to cut checks due to the possibility of missing the funding
 deadline. It was viewed that membership should be researching corrective measures to prevent
 such incidents occurring in their own jurisdiction.
- Discussing the possibilities of a jurisdiction not being able to fund the clearinghouse, it was
 determined that the data should still be uploaded. If a member jurisdiction is aware that they will
 not meet the funding deadline, IFTA, Inc. could pull them from the disbursement aspect and
 provide the pertinent data so that checks could be issued and distributed. Not providing the data
 timely and having it roll into the next cycle would be detrimental to the funds netting process as a
 whole.
- Oklahoma, Newfoundland, and Quebec have yet to become full members of the IFTA clearinghouse. Alberta will implement in the near future and is working on the "penny test."
- Following discussions of the language of the Agreement, it was decided that the Agreement Procedures Committee (APC) should be contacted regarding the possibility of a ballot proposing that all IFTA-related documents be transmitted in English only.
- The 2017 Funds Netting Calendar was approved by the Board as presented.
- A Committee Chairs Conference Call was held with the Board. Chairs participating on this call
 were: Ms. Marie Stark (MT), APC, Mr. David Nicholson (OK), Audit Committee, Ms. Scott Miller
 (KS), Information Technology Advisory Committee, Ms. Sukanya Mukherjee (MD), Attorneys'
 Section Steering Committee, Inspector Andrew Markle (ON), Law Enforcement Committee, and
 Mr. Paul Bernander (WI), to report on an electronic credentials pilot being led by Wisconsin.
- During the Comptroller's report, Mrs. Amanda Koeller updated the Board on the rental units, gave the financial report, which included membership dues status.
- In August 2016 the center unit's lease will be up for renewal. The end unit recently renewed for a
 five year lease expiring in 2020. IFTA, Inc. continues to work with a local realtor to ensure the
 best and fairest prices are offered to the tenants.

- The Board was informed that some jurisdictions have yet to pay their 2015/2016 membership dues. IFTA, Inc. remains in contact with these jurisdictions. Inquiries were made as to what type of penalties existed for members that pay their membership dues late or not at all. Currently there is no monetary assessment, but a member could be in jeopardy of losing their voting rights. It was decided that letters should be addressed to those jurisdictions in arears for their membership dues, addressing the specific reasons as to why they may be late in payment. IFTA, Inc. explained that the non-payment of membership dues impacts the IFTA, Inc. budget negatively. IFTA, Inc. will also work on amending the organization's financial policy clarifying the necessity of timely payment of membership dues and the effects of non-payment of the dues.
- The Board approved the 2017 IFTA decal specifications as amended. Additionally, the Board opted to allow IFTA, Inc. to review, update, and approve the decal specifications for all future releases without the requirement of the Board approval. It was further decided that the specifications could be provided for multiple years to help those members that are interested in pre-ordering their jurisdiction's decals.
- The 2016 program compliance reviews have all been scheduled and will be electronic. These
 reviews will range from a two-year review to a six-year review. The two-year reviews will
 concentrate on the non-compliance issues found during their previous reviews. The more
 complete, six-year reviews will encompass the entire, standard review.
- PCR training webinars for the 2016 reviewers have been scheduled for November 18th. Two
 webinars will be held; one for the administrative reviewers and one for the auditor reviewers. The
 scope of these webinars will be to train on how to complete a program compliance review.
- Referencing volunteers for the PCR teams, Mrs. Debora Meise, IFTA, Inc. Senior Director, explained that jurisdictions need to provide qualified personnel to conduct the review. While new employees would be welcomed to observe the review, jurisdictions are being asked to ensure an experienced volunteer is also provided.
- Mrs. Tammy Trinker, IFTA, Inc. Office and Events Administrator informed the Board that there
 were a total of seventeen (17) persons that attended the 2015 IFTA Attorneys' Meeting in San
 Antonio, TX. This meeting was 1.5 days and held alongside the IFTA/IRP Managers' and Law
 Enforcement Workshop that was hosted by IRP, Inc.
- The Board listened to recommendations that the next meeting be held alongside the Annual IFTA Business Meeting in 2017 over the course of a single day. This recommendation was based on the elapsed time from October 2015 to August 2016 of ten months. There was concern that pairing the IFTA Attorneys' Meeting with the 2016 Annual IFTA Business Meeting would prohibit travel for some due to the amount of time following the previous meeting.
- The Board approved the 2016 registration fees for the IFTA/IRP Audit Workshop. The fees for this workshop will be \$350 for members, \$400 for general public and industry representatives, and \$700 for exhibitors.
- The Board was informed that a hotel contract has been received and is being negotiated for the 2016 Annual IFTA Business Meeting. This meeting will be held in Indianapolis, IN at the Hyatt Regency in early August.

- A trial pilot project being led by Wisconsin for the purpose of exploring the enforcement of electronic credentials was discussed. Mr. Paul Bernander (WI) had led this discussion during the Conference Call. He explained that a request was made during the August 2015 Annual IFTA Business Meeting to have volunteers for a pilot project regarding electronic credentials. A charter and handbook have been drafted and forwarded to IFTA, Inc. for review. Mr. Bernander is looking to secure approval from the WI State Patrol and DMV following the Board meeting. Once this approval has been given, WI will work with adjacent IFTA member jurisdictions to join the pilot project. The basic premise of the pilot project is to have PDF versions of the IFTA license that could be shown electronically at the roadside. During the pilot, all participating licensees will be required to carry both paper and electronic versions of their IFTA license.
- Reviewing the 2015 Annual IFTA Business Meeting, it was decided that a hard copy of a blank
 proxy form would be provided at all of the voting delegate tables in the future. This should
 eliminate occurrences where voting is required, but not enough delegates are in the room at the
 time of the vote. With the blank proxies being provided, delegates that are unexpectedly called
 away from the meeting for a period of time could leave a signed proxy authorizing another
 delegate to record a vote on their behalf.
- The 2014 ballots were reviewed. Ballot 3-2014 is out for vote. At the time of the Board meeting, the vote was 28 to 2 in favor. Voting for this ballot closes on November 19th.
- The seven 2015 ballots are out for a second comment period. The second comment period will close on November 30th.
- The IRP, Inc. ballot, 2015.01, passed with a 97% approval rating based on 30 to 1 in favor of the ballot. This ballot addresses audit procedures within IRP.
- The Board discussed the ballot voting method of IRP and questioned whether IFTA should use a similar method. Mr. Trent Knoles (IL) and Mrs. Cindy Arnold (NV) agreed to draft a ballot proposal for 2016 that would amend the IFTA voting procedures. During discussions, it was decided that the ballot could be drafted by the Board, but once it was prepared it could be tasked to a jurisdiction to sponsor the ballot.
- The logistics of the 1Q16 Board meeting were reviewed. This Board meeting will be held in Las Vegas, NV, at the Tuscany. The Board will need to travel on a Sunday in order to be present for the meeting on Monday, February 8, 2016. The meeting would conclude on Tuesday, February 9; this is also the first day of the IFTA/IRP Audit Workshop. The Board meeting will be open to those persons who would like to attend the meeting. As this meeting will be held out of state and away from the IFTA, Inc. offices, there will be no Committee Chairs Conference Call during this Board meeting.
- During the New Business, IFTA, Inc. informed the Board that the Bylaws would be reviewed and cleaned up. The amended Bylaws would be presented to the Board for consideration at a later date.
- An issue presented by Indiana was also reviewed by the Board during the New Business.
 Indiana had submitted an informal request for interpretation. This request inquired about the renewal period for displaying IFTA credentials and questioned whether the carrier needed to retain the 2015/2016 decals on the vehicles or if the carrier would be valid with just the 2016 decal if displayed as early as December 1st. Indiana explained that these carriers would maintain the 2015 cab card until January 2016.

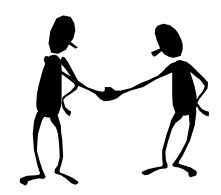
- The Board determined that an informal response to Indiana's request would not be binding and that, if a Board interpretation was being requested, that more data would be required and a formal Consensus Board Interpretation Draft would need to be submitted.
- The Law Enforcement Committee Best Practices Guide and Brochure were also discussed during
 the New Business. It was noted that both documents would need to be reviewed and revised
 prior to the Board's final approval for release. IFTA, Inc. will work with the committee to finalize
 both documents so that they could be re-presented to the Board for approval.
- An in-depth review of the Strategic Plan was done. The action items were assessed a priority level to best complete the Plan.

Following all discussions, the Board adjourned the Fourth Quarter 2015 IFTA, Inc. Board of Trustees meeting.

New Transmittal Reports

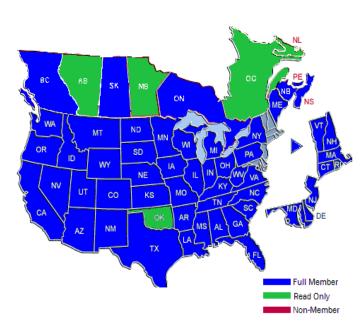
