# ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT AND RESTATEMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF INTERNATIONAL FUEL TAX ASSOCIATION, INC.

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede and take the place of the heretofore existing Articles of Incorporation and any amendments or restatements thereof of International Fuel Tax Association, Inc., all pursuant to the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Act, Sections 10-3101 through 10-11702 of the Arizona Revised Statutes ("ANCA").

## ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation is "International Fuel Tax Association, Inc." The corporation is hereafter referred to as the "Association".

## ARTICLE II PURPOSE AND CHARACTER OF AFFAIRS

The Association is organized and shall be operated exclusively for the purpose of engaging in the administration and management of International Fuel Tax Agreement and managing a data repository, communication with members and organizational meetings as necessary within the meaning of I.R.C. § 501(c)(6). The Association may carry out its purposes directly or by making gifts, grants or other payments to other qualifying organizations. In these Articles, the term "I.R.C." means the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and references to provisions thereof are to such provisions as they are from time to time amended and to corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

## ARTICLE III ACTIVITIES AND RESTRICTIONS

<u>Section 1</u>. No dividends, liquidating dividends, or distributions shall be declared or paid by the Association to any private individual or officer or trustee of the Association.

Section 2. No substantial part of the activities of the Association shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, unless by appropriate election a greater part is permitted without jeopardizing the Association's exemption under I.R.C. § 501(c)(3). The Association shall neither participate in, nor intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of any statements.

Section 3. No part of the net earnings or net income of the Association shall inure to the benefit of any private individual or officer or trustee of the Association; provided, however, that such a person may receive reasonable compensation for personal services rendered, or

reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred, which are necessary to carrying out the exempt purposes of the Association.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under I.R.C. § 501(c)(6).

## ARTICLE IV MEMBERS

The Association shall have one or more classes of members whose respective qualifications, rights, and method of acceptance shall be as specified in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE V BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by its Board of Trustees, which currently consist of nine (9), and shall in the future consist of such number of persons as shall be fixed by the Bylaws from time to time, but shall not be less than the number of trustees required by the ANCA which is one (1). The terms of office, qualifications and method of election of the trustees shall be as specified in the Bylaws. The names and addresses of the current trustees are:

## ARTICLE VI AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the Trustees of the Association by vote of a majority (51%) of the number of Trustees at a meeting at which a quorum is present, provided that no amendment shall substantially change the original purposes of the Association.

## ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of the Association, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Association, distribute all of the assets of the Association exclusively to one or more organizations then described in I.R.C. §§§ 501(c)(3), 501(c)(4) or 501(c)(6) having purposes substantially similar to those of the Association or to one or more units or agencies of federal, state or local government to be used exclusively for public purposes, as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so distributed shall be distributed to one or more of such organizations as determined by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the Association is then located.

## ARTICLE VIII PRINCIPAL OFFICE; REGISTERED OFFICE; REGISTERED AGENT

The street address of the principal office is 14517 W. Cortez Street, Surprise, Arizona 85379. The mailing and street address of the registered office is 12725 W. Indian School Road, Suite E-101, Avondale, Arizona 85392 and the registered agent at such address is Arizona Statutory Agent Services, LLC.

## ARTICLE IX TRUSTEE LIABILITY

To the fullest extent permitted by the ANCA as the same exist or may be hereafter amended, no trustee of the Association shall be liable to the Association for monetary damages for any action taken or any failure to take any action as a trustee. No repeal, amendment or modification of this article, whether direct or indirect, shall eliminate or reduce its effect with respect to any act or failure to act of a trustee of the Association occurring prior to such repeal, amendment or modification.

## ARTICLE XI INDEMNIFICATION

The Association shall, to the fullest extent permitted or required by Sections 10-3850 to 10-3858, inclusive, of the ANCA, including any amendments thereto (but in the case of any such amendment, only to the extent such amendment permits or requires the Association to provide broader indemnification rights than prior to such amendment), indemnify its current and former Trustees, Officers, and agents against any and all Liabilities, and advance any and all reasonable Expenses, incurred thereby in any Proceeding to which any Trustee or Officer is a Party because such Trustee or Officer is a Trustee or Officer of the Association; provided, however, that the Association's obligation of indemnification shall be conditioned upon its receipt of prompt written

notice of the threat or filing of an action, suit or proceeding as to which rights of indemnification are sought. The Association may indemnify its employees and authorized agents, acting within the scope of their duties as such, to the same extent as Trustees or Officers hereunder. The rights to indemnification granted hereunder shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to indemnification against Liabilities or the advancement of Expenses which such Trustee or Officer may be entitled under any written agreement, board resolution, vote of the Members, the ANCA or otherwise. All capitalized terms used in this section and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in Section 10-3850 of the ANCA.
