Updates:

IFTA/IRP Workshop – The workshop is tentatively scheduled for April, May, or June 2021. Board Update – David said the ABM went well.

GPS Standardized Data Output Working Group: David said the group is doing a tremendous job. He said they will be sending out a questionnaire in the near future, and he anticipates having new language fairly soon. Debbie offered to help send out the questionnaires.
