- 3. Approved March 2020 meeting minutes (Motion by Dave, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Andy)-April meeting canceled-no minutes
- 4. Board update:
  - Richard Wagner: Spring meeting conducted by phone, monitoring the ABM so far it is still a go, discussed upcoming Ballot, discussed Board's ability to override due dates for tax returns and decal renewal, discussed returns filed and paid, and that carrier operations had a drop in miles

- Scott Bryer: Executive Committee call with IRP to discuss workshops going forward, discussed bylaw changes and amendments for Executive Committee and language changes, discussed upcoming Ballot

#### 8. 2020 IFTA/IRP Managers' and LE Workshop:

- Len McLaughlin: Last meeting before COVID 19 a sub-committee was formed to go through the topics for the presentations, no decision on where or if the workshop is going to be held or how it might be held
- Eric Belford: Results of the survey indicated that topics on fraud training were the most popular, committee is looking at combining sessions or having 1 big presentation with many parts, also popular were chameleon carriers, virtual offices and the round tables, if you have ideas share them with Eric, Len and Kim, also discussed was the idea of detailed breakouts for LE, MT is also seeing issues with virtual offices
- Richard Wagner: Topics of bogus and sham addresses, issues leading to Real ID fraud, there needs to be vigilance and sharing of information

• Dave Bales: Working with the CAC for more reliable in-time information and easier access, discussed idea of taking VINs out if leased and not working and recording of decals, email sent seeking input

#### **Education charge issued by IFTA Board**:

• Barb Arkwright: Discussed the purpose of the Charge, Kim and Andy are assisting, update for next meeting

#### 13. M&M Blitz Update:

- Eric Belford: Reached out and many states didn't conduct or are not planning on conducting a May Blitz, discussed the potential of pushing it off to end of summer or fall, discussed to keep on the agenda for follow up
- Len McLaughlin: Reached out and many states not participating due to the extensions
- Barb Arkwright: Reported good participation in March from VA, SC, KY, not sure what May is going to bring, VA Weigh Stations are being used for truck parking
- Dave Bales: Reported NE participated in March, KS canceled, discussed Governor's emergency declaration
- Andy Player: ME DMV closed so carriers are unable to obtain credentials, discussed that the throttling back of enforcement is creating egregious offenses

- Joe Hatcher: MD had a successful March Blitz, MD May has been suspended
- Chase Johnson: NC Weigh Stations are closed, suggests pushing off until safer time

- Len McLaughlin: Reported appearance of confusion in the use of Dyed Diesel fuel by the public and LE
- Dave Bales: Reported that March didn't seem to have the numbers for the Blitz that has been seen in previous years
