- 1) Is the 10-unit sample as a whole representative? Why or why not?
- 2) Are there any units within the sample that should be isolated, excluded or replaced? Which units? What would you do with it? Why?
- 3) What methods and/or considerations would you use to determine whether the sample units and quarters are representative of all quarters of the audit period?
- 4) If the drivers' trip sheets only contain marginal information and do not tie completely with the summary, what considerations would you make regarding projected (or audited) distance and/or any corresponding fuel? What about the MPG?
- 5) Does your jurisdiction have minimum requirements regarding the number of units or jurisdictions that must be represented in the sample? If so, how is it determined?
- 6) Does your jurisdiction have a minimum threshold when determining whether to apply an error factor, hold the reported values, or isolate an error? If so, what threshold is used and how was it established?
- 7) What other methods might be used to get a representative sample?
