



Code of Conduct at IFTA and IRP Events

Events of members of the International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) and the International Registration Plan (IRP) communities provide outstanding opportunities to foster professional development, share best practices and promote efficient and effective Agreement and Plan administration.

Both IFTA, Inc. and IRP, Inc. strive to provide an optimal atmosphere for collegial discussion and exchange at all co-sponsored events. The Organizations are committed to fostering a positive environment at all events, based upon trust, respect, open communications and ethical behavior. The Board of Trustees of IFTA, Inc. and the Board of Directors at IRP, Inc. have adopted this Code of Conduct at all co-sponsored events to promote these values.

Participants in any events must avoid inappropriate actions or comments based on race, gender, age, religion, sexual orientation. Event participants should interact with other event attendees in a cooperative and collegial manner and show consistent respect to other participants at all times.

Violations of this Code of Conduct should be reported promptly to a team member of IFTA, Inc. or IRP, Inc. In cases of violations of this Code of Conduct Policy the Board of Trustees and the Board of Directors shall authorize such actions as may be appropriate, including but not limited to requiring participants to leave an event and precluding event attendees who have violated this Code of Conduct from attending future events.
