Notice of Waiver of International Registration Plan (IRP), International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA), and OS/OW Permit Requirements for Maine

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor of the State of Maine has issued the attached Proclamation of State of Civil Emergency. Effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020, the Maine Bureau of Motor Vehicles is closed until further notice and is now unable to process IRP, IFTA and OS/OW transactions and therefore we are unable to ensure that registrants and licensees will have proper operating credentials. At this time, we ask that all IRP and IFTA jurisdictions waive and delay enforcement action on these vehicles operating in your jurisdiction for the next 30 days. If the proclamation is extended, we will ask jurisdictions to continue to waive and delay enforcement action until Maine is no longer under a State of Civil Emergency.
