

INTERNATIONAL FUEL TAX AGREEMENT

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE CHARTER

(Adopted April 1998)

- I. **NAME:** The name of this committee shall be the International Fuel Tax Agreement ("IFTA") Law Enforcement Committee ("Committee").
- II. **AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE:** The Committee is established by the IFTA Articles of Agreement pursuant to Article R1810.600. The Committee acts as a liaison between the fuel tax administrators within the IFTA membership and the fuel tax enforcement community by creating interest and promoting uniformity in fuel tax enforcement.
- III. **COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES:** The Committee has the responsibility of advising the IFTA membership regarding law enforcement matters and such other responsibilities as specified in the IFTA or assigned to it by the International Fuel Tax Association, Inc. ("IFTA, Inc.") Board of Trustees ("Board"). In discharging these responsibilities, the Committee shall seek input from the Agreement Procedures Committee, Audit Committee, Program Compliance Review Committee, and Industry Advisory Committee.
- IV. **MEMBERSHIP:** The Board President, with the approval of the Board, shall appoint a Committee Chair. No member of the Board shall serve as Chair of the Law Enforcement Committee. The Chair shall select the committee members to serve on the Committee, subject to the approval of the Board. The committee members will be representatives of law enforcement agencies of member jurisdictions having the responsibility to enforce laws affecting motor carriers, including the IFTA. The Committee shall determine its membership rotation policy subject to approval of the Board.
- V. **SUBCOMMITTEES:** The Committee may, with the approval of the Board Liaison, establish subcommittees to review specific issues before the Committee. Such subcommittees shall report results to the Committee for consideration.

- VI. **VACANCIES:** The Committee Chair shall nominate to the Board a replacement for a vacancy occurring on the Committee. The vacancy shall then be filled by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board. A committee member elected to fill a vacancy shall serve the unexpired term of his or her predecessor as defined by the Committee rotation policy developed pursuant to Paragraph IV.
- VII. **CHARTER AMENDMENT:** Amendments to this Charter may be submitted to IFTA, Inc. by any member of the Committee. IFTA, Inc. shall circulate the proposed Charter amendments to the members of the Committee. The Committee may recommend to the Board amendments to this Charter. The proposed amendments will be considered by the Board.
