IRP Best Practices: problems with some jurisdictions issuing citations for GVWR vs registered weight. Very comprehensive document. Use as guideline for customers/clients, etc.

Electronic Credentials: Tim Adams making presentation at Mgr's/LEC meeting. Hope to make progress this year to be able to ballot in IFTA and IRP next year. Will change to Electronic Record (vs. Electronic Credential). CIVISN shows that the technology is there. Work with vendors to establish the standard data criteria.

IRP Audit Committee is planning for the 2017 audit workshop. Best practices has been the focus until now.

IRP Education Committee revisited the webinars and have updated them. Talked about chameleon carriers. Virtual round table on FRP 18 months later will be the next delivery.
